 Approval of 2023 Levy Certification and Ordinance/Resolution 2022-11-02 – Board Action

Summary: In 2018 the voters passed a levy lid lift increasing the property tax rate to \$1.25 per thousand of assessed valuation and authorized setting the levy limit factor to 106% for the five succeeding years (not to exceed \$1.25 per thousand).

3. Approve Resolution 2022-11-01 for 2023 Final Budget Adoption – Board Action

Operating Budget \$715,760.72 Capital/Debt \$136,207.36

4. Approve continuation in the Washington Fire Commissioners health care plan – Board Action

Summary: Annually, the district is required by the WFCA health care program to submit an employer application and eligibility/contribution form. There is a 2.5% increase in the PPO care premiums for 2023.
